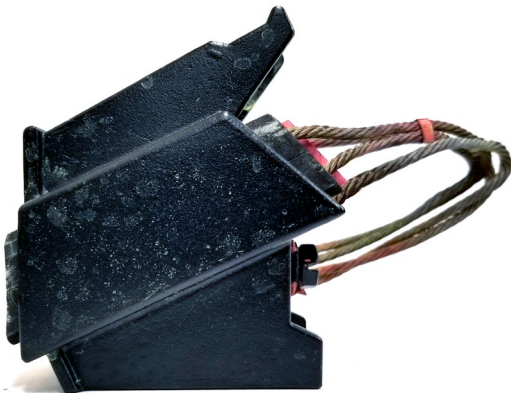

- The corrosion of the brush holder causes brush hang ups, leading to arcs and sparks, motor failure and inevitable downtime!

- Compared to nickel and duplex of silver over copper, Teflon™ is the superior coating for pickling lines

- All Helwig holders can be Teflon™ coated for durability

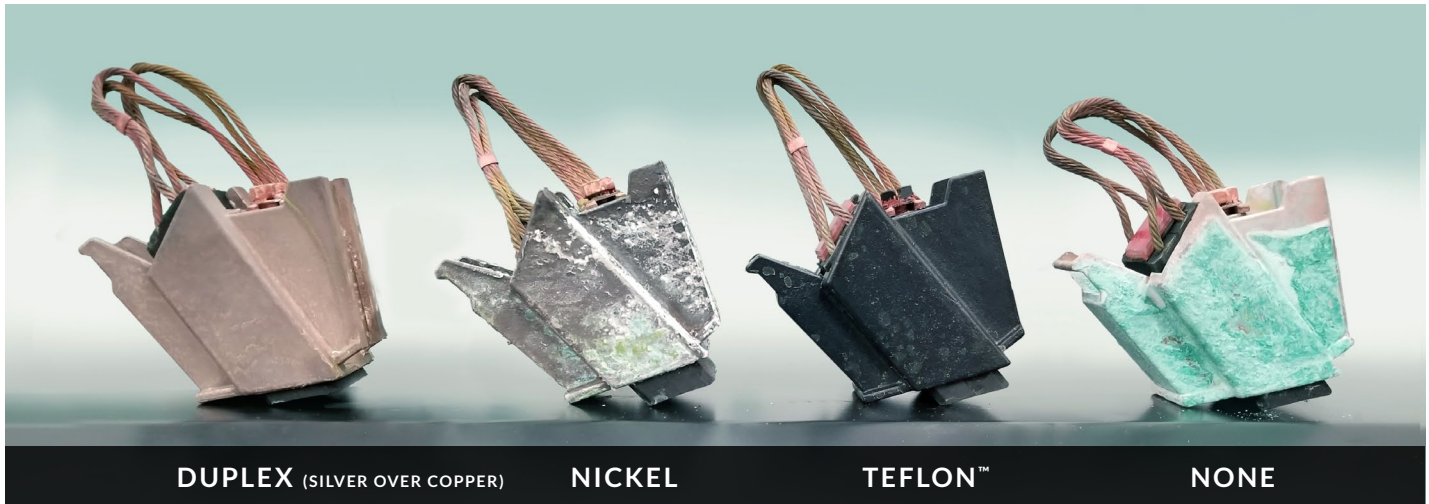
